

Confirmation of the Effectiveness of Bacoban against Ebola

Filoviruses such as the ebolavirus can remain infectious for anything between five days and three weeks. The ebolavirus is as a rule spread by way of body fluids. It is therefore recommended to use the surface disinfectant under the application conditions "dirty conditions".

If Bacoban WB (1% dilution with water) is applied, disinfected surfaces should only be re-used again after 5 minutes.

The deactivation of ebolaviruses calls for products that are effective against enveloped viruses.

Bacoban WB products have a "limited virucidal effect" and therewith meet the requirements specified by the Robert Koch Institute for deactivating ebolaviruses.
